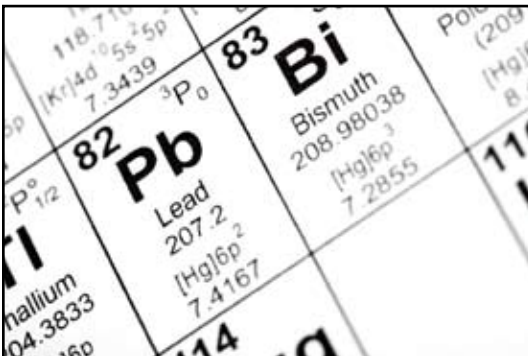

Inez Moore Tenenbaum was nominated by President Barack Obama on June 9, 2009 to serve as the ninth Chairman of the U.S. Consumer

Product Safety Commission. Ms. Tenenbaum was confirmed by the Senate on June 19, 2009 and sworn into office on June 23 to a term that expires on October 2013.

For her keynote address, Ms. Tenenbaum will provide an update on CPSC issues as they relate to footwear and what to expect in the months and years ahead, followed by a brief Q&A session.
